Cain and Abel offer sacrifices to G-d, and Abel's sacrifice is accepted while Cain's is rejected. This brings Cain to kill Abel, and Cain is then banished to a lifetime of wandering the earth. The parsha goes on to list the first 10 generations of humanity (from Adam through Noah), and describes the way humankind's relationship with G-d becomes worse over time.
