Next, we read about Adam and Chava in Gan Eden, including Chava's encounter with the serpent in which she and Adam ate the fruit of the Eitz HaDa'at Tov v'Ra. This act led to the expulsion of Adam and Chava from Gan Eden. Their sons, Kayin and Hevel, offer sacrifices to Hashem, with Hevel's sacrifice accepted while Kayin's is rejected. Kayin kills Hevel, and Kayin is banished to a lifetime of wandering the earth. The first 10 generations of humanity are recorded (from Adam through Noach), and humankind's relationship with Hashem becomes worse over time.
